## <u>ORDER</u>

Pending before the Court are motions to dismiss filed by the Tennessee Department of Education and Penny Schwinn, Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Education (Doc. No. 46) and the Williamson County Board of Education and Jason Golden, Director of Williamson County Public Schools (Doc. No. 48), which are fully briefed (*see* Doc. Nos. 62, 65, 66).

For the reasons stated in the accompanying Memorandum, Defendants' motions to dismiss (Doc. Nos. 46 and 48) are **DENIED** as to Plaintiff's equal protection claim, and **GRANTED** as to Plaintiff's Title IX claim. To the extent Plaintiff brings a separate claim related to her school records, that claim is **DISMISSED** without prejudice. The claims against Jason Golden, Director of Williamson County Public Schools are also **DISMISSED**.

In light of the foregoing, the Motion for Review of the Magistrate Judge's Order denying a stay of discovery (Doc. No. 70) is **MOOT**.

It is so **ORDERED**.
